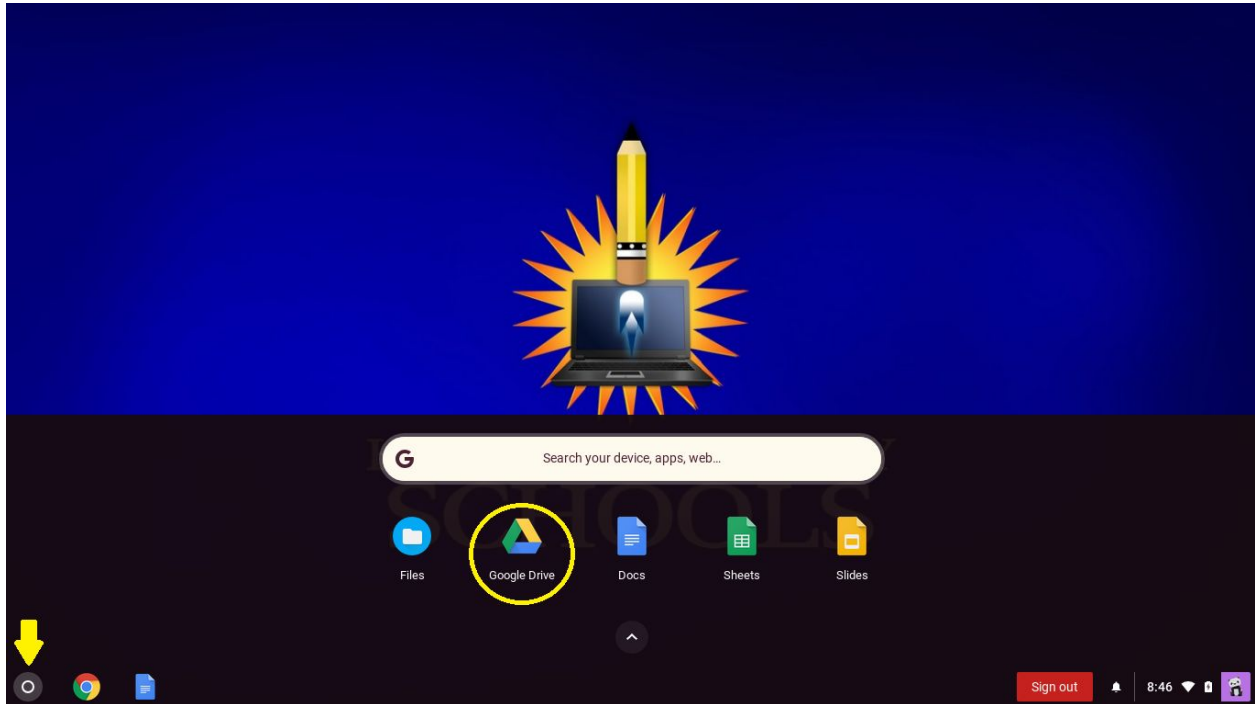
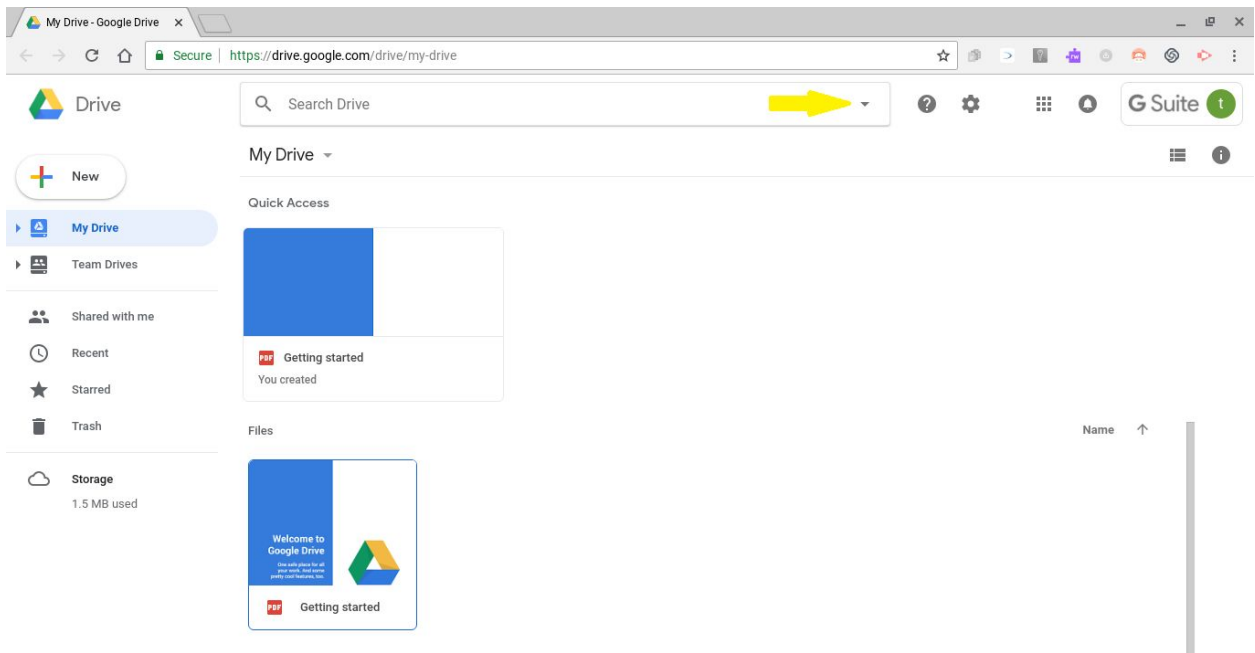


Instructions for Accessing Offline Content:

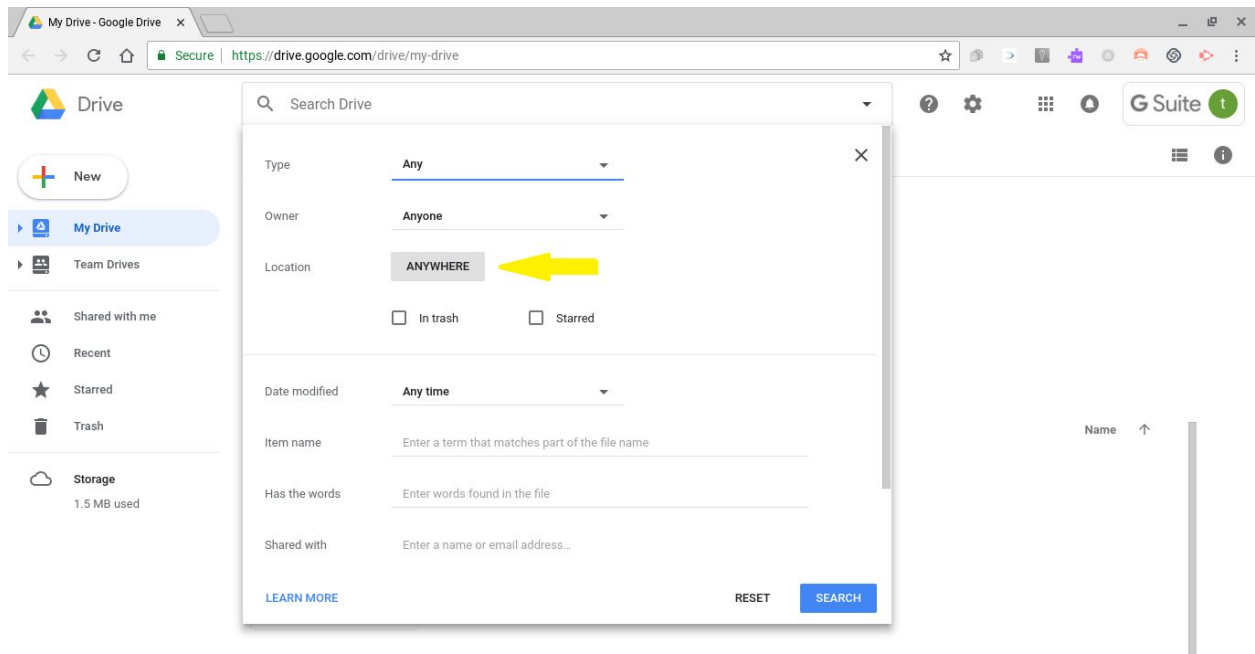
1. First click the Launcher icon and select Google Drive



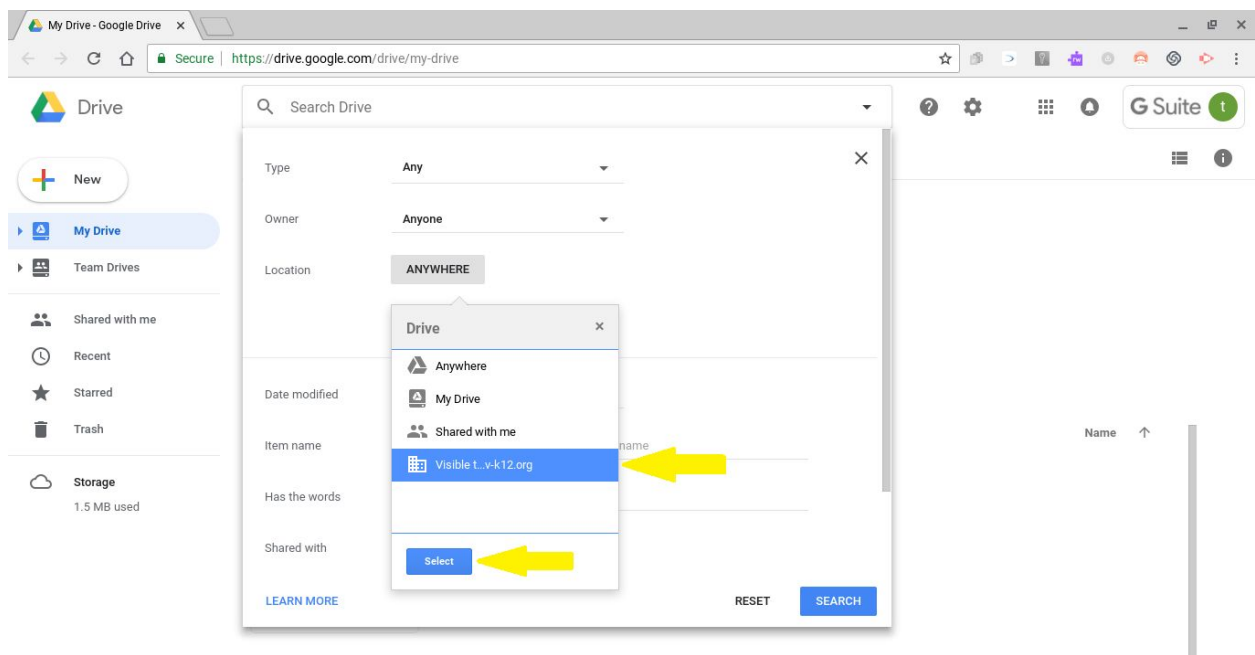
2. Once you have arrived at the Google drive page, click the drop-down shown by the yellow arrow.



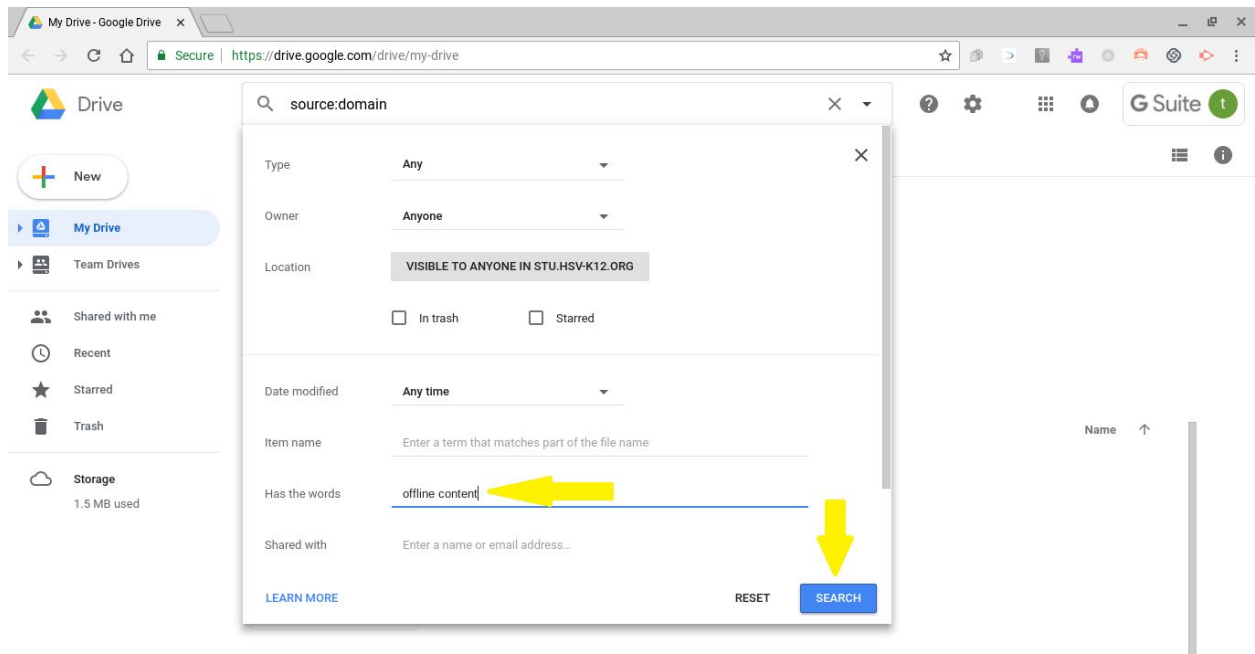
3. On the newly opened window, click the word “ANYWHERE” shown by the yellow arrow.



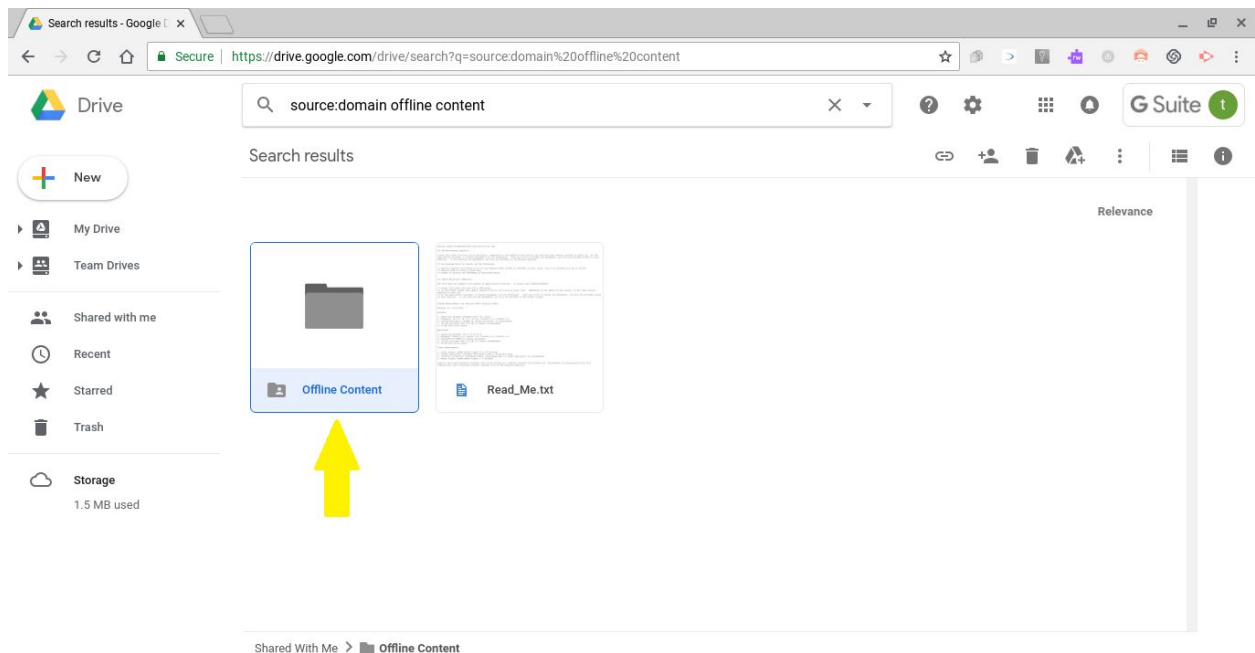
4. Click the option “Visible t...v-k12.org”, then click Select.



5. Next type in “Offline Content” shown by the yellow arrow and then click Search.

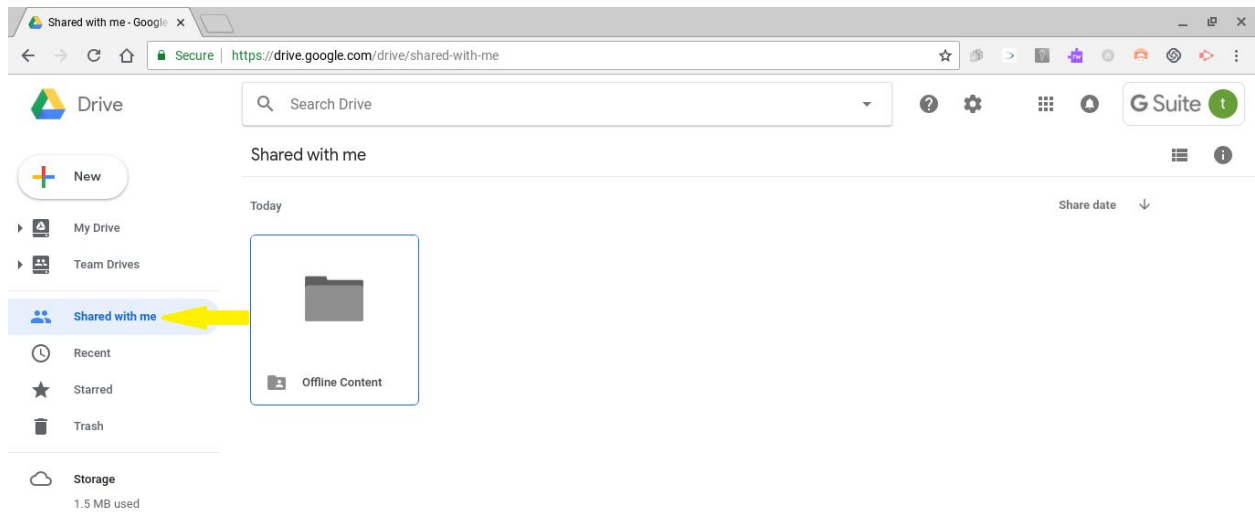


6. Once the search results appear, double-click the Offline Content folder.



7. You have now successfully added the Offline Content to your Google Drive.
